

We are also working with many buyers who are engaging in multiple offer scenarios on a regular basis with inventory levels still much lower than desired. Like you, we are busy arranging spring clean-ups, renewing maintenance contracts and scheduling the opening of irrigation systems for the upcoming season.

As we all start to spend more time outside, it is a popular time to clean up your landscaping beds, fertilize your lawn and give the whole property a good spring cleaning.

Year to Date in Summerland we have reported 62 unit sales, which is down 46.55% from this same time last year. The Average Sale Price for a Single Family Home in Summerland is \$917,423 and there are currently 768 properties for sale in the South Okanagan.








Unit Sales By Price Point March 2022 vs. 2021




